During this grace period, participants are no longer in F-1/J-visa status and are under the jurisdiction of the USCIS. The USCIS grants this period to allow participants to settle their affairs and prepare to return to their home countries. Program participants may no longer continue and/or complete their program activities, nor may they work.
