ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS.

How do I get started?

UNDERGRADUATE

- Make sure you meet our minimum requirements.
First Year: fewer than 26 college credits /
Transfer: more than 12 college credits
- Apply online. \$40 fee
- Send us your transcripts from high school or college as appropriate.
- Send the required financial statement.
- We'll email you if we need more documents.
- There is no application deadline.
- SAT/ ACT not required for admission, but may be required for some scholarships.

GRADUATE

- Apply online directly to the program. Requirements and specific degrees offered differ by program.
- Minimum requirements:
 - Master's degree: 2.7 GPA on 4.0 scale and 3.0 GPA on all previous graduate work
 - Doctoral program: 3.0 on all previous graduate-level coursework
- Send relevant transcripts and test scores if required. Test scores may include the GRE and English-proficiency scores.
- Send the required financial clearance / proof of funds.
- Your program will contact you about further requirements and admission status.

If you are admitted

- We'll email you about immigration documents and requirements.
- You can contact your academic advisor and enroll in classes.
