

## **Reinstatement of Immigration Status**

A student who has failed to maintain F-1 student status (including but not limited to: carrying a full course load, late extension of program or missing a semester of classes) may be reinstated to F-1 status at the discretion of the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS).

<u>IMPORTANT</u>: Students who have been out of status for more than five (5) months must demonstrate that the failure to file for reinstatement within the five (5) month period was as a result of exceptional circumstances and that the student filed the request as promptly as possible under the exceptional circumstances.

To apply for reinstatement you will need:

- 1. Form I-539 completed by the student. (available at: <u>http://www.uscis.gov/files/form/i-539.pdf</u>)
- 2. Form I-20 (prepared by International Programs and Services).
- 4. Photocopy of your SIUC original entry I-20.
- 5. \$290.00 (processing fee ) check or money order made out to "U.S. Department of Homeland Security".
- 6. **Original I-94** card.
- 7. Current **visa** and **Passport**.
- 8. Letter from the student containing the following:
  - The explanation as to how you violated your status (i.e. dropped a class without permission, allowed Form I-20 to expire, etc...)
  - The violation of status resulted from circumstances beyond your control (or) that failure to receive a reinstatement would result in extreme hardship to you.
  - That you are currently pursuing, or intending to pursue, a full-time course of study.
  - That you have not been engaged in unauthorized employment.
  - That you are not in deportation proceedings.
- 9. Financial Statement
- 10. **Letter from your academic advisor** indicating your new graduation date and that you are currently enrolled as a full time student.
- 11. Payment receipt for SEVIS I-901 fee if more than five months out of status
- 12. SIUC transcript in a sealed envelope.

When all of the items are complete, **please call 618-453-5774 and ask to make an appointment for reinstatement.** An adviser will review all of the information and prepare a letter of support prior to your submitting the application to USCIS.
